Developing Marketing Plan for Vacant Buildings

The District has been working with Mitch Foster, City Manager of the City of Ludington, who has confirmed that developers have expressed interest in the District's properties that will become vacant. A developer has confirmed interest with the City Manager in Foster Elementary and Lakeview Elementary School. The City Manager has requested that the District review records to determine whether environmental studies have been completed on either of these properties. Potential grant opportunities exist for developers to improve and re-purpose these sites. Discussed opportunities include the improvement of the building into a housing complex at Foster Elementary, and the use of Lakeview was not discussed, although interest was expressed in the building.
