This assurance provides that the bonds will be qualified. Assurance from the State Treasurer has been attached to this memo, along with the resolution. The Board will need to adopt the attached resolution calling the election on Tuesday, May 7, 2019.

The deadline for certification of the ballot to the election coordinator and election clerk(s) is Tuesday, February 12, 2019 before 4:00 p.m.

Resolution to Call Bond Election

The Board will need an action item to approve the attached resolution to call the bond election on Tuesday, May 7, 2019.

A special meeting of the board of education of the District (the "Board") was held in the, within the boundaries of the District, on the
4th day of February, 2019, at o'clock in them.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member and supported by Member:
WHEREAS:

- 1. In the opinion of this Board it is necessary and expedient to ask voters whether to approve a bond project consisting of erecting, furnishing, and equipping a new elementary school building; erecting, furnishing, and equipping additions to the middle/high school building; remodeling, equipping and re-equipping, and furnishing and refurnishing school buildings; acquiring, installing, and equipping or re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; erecting a new team room and concession building for ball fields; purchasing school buses; and preparing, developing, improving, and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, and sites.
- 2. This Board estimates the necessary cost of the project to be One Hundred Two Million One Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$102,127,173).
- 3. It will be necessary for the District to borrow the sum of One Hundred Million Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$100,935,000) and issue the bonds of the District therefor, the remaining funds to be derived from the investment of the bond proceeds.
- 4. This Board intends to submit a proposition at a special election to be held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019.
- 5. On or before 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 12, 2019, the Board shall certify any ballot proposition to be submitted to the voters at such election to the election coordinator or coordinators designated to conduct elections within the District (the "Election Coordinator").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. A special election of the school electors of the District be called and held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019.
- 2. The proposition to be voted on at the special election shall be stated on the ballots in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit A.
- 3. The Election Coordinator is requested to:

- a. Utilize ______, a newspaper published or of general circulation within the District, for publication of notices in accordance with the election law requirements.
- b. Utilize ballot proposition summary information, as prepared by legal counsel, in the forms of the notices of last day of registration and election in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto.
- c. Provide a proof copy of the ballot to the District and its legal counsel in sufficient time to allow the ballot to be proofread prior to printing.
- 4. This Board estimates the period of usefulness of the improvements for which bonds of the District in the amount of One Hundred Million Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$100,935,000) are to be issued to be not less than thirty (30) years.
- 5. The Secretary of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this resolution with the Election Coordinator and with any Election Clerk or clerks designated to conduct elections within the District by 4:00 p.m., on Tuesday, February 12, 2019.
- 6. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.

EXHIBIT A

LUDINGTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Ludington Area School District, Mason County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed One Hundred Million Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$100,935,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing, and equipping a new elementary school building; erecting, furnishing, and equipping additions to the middle/high school building; remodeling, equipping and re-equipping, and furnishing and refurnishing school buildings; acquiring, installing, and equipping or re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; erecting a new team room and concession building for ball fields; purchasing school buses; and preparing, developing, improving, and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2019, under current law, is 2.32 mills (\$2.32 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 1.71 mills net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.58 mills (\$2.58 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$-0-. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$-0-. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
